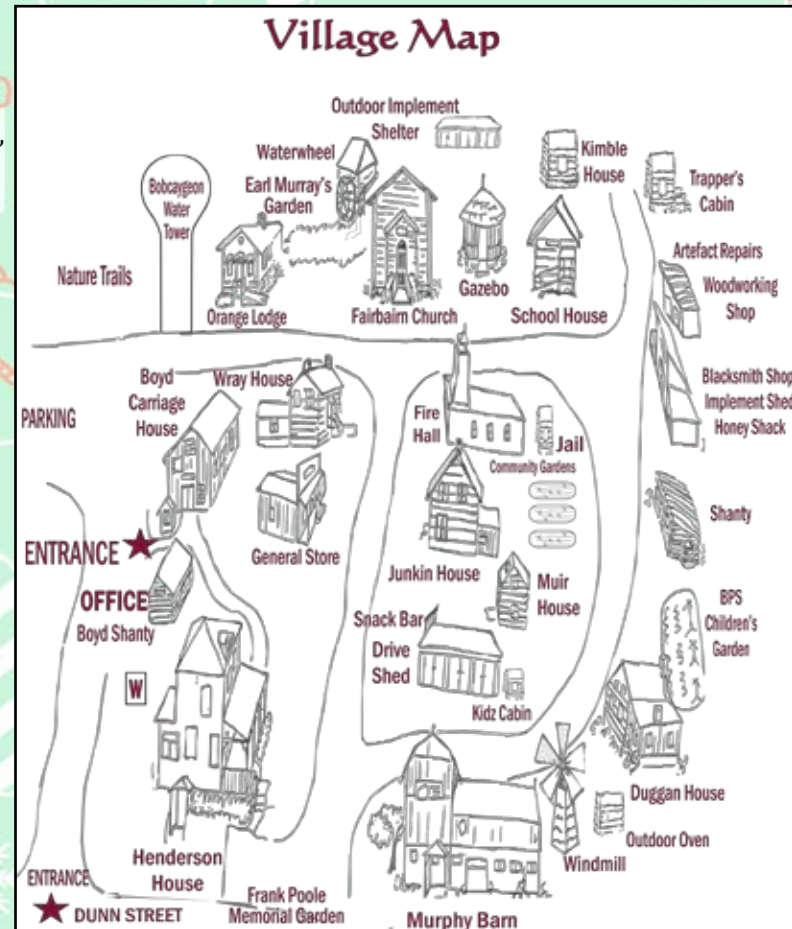
Twilight Auction
